

Rules of Membership

In the Telecommunications Technology Association of Korea (TTA)

Article 1 (Purpose)

The purpose of these rules is to ensure rational and efficient management of the business of the Telecommunications Technology Association of Korea (hereinafter referred to as “TTA”) by stipulating matters regarding membership in TTA and members’ participation in the activities of TTA, in accordance with the provisions of Article 26 Paragraph 3, of the Articles of Association.

Article 2 (Categories of Membership and Requisite Qualifications)

- ① Membership in TTA (hereinafter referred to as “membership”) shall be classified into two categories: ordinary membership and special membership.
- ② Ordinary members shall be entities such as companies, corporations and business firms, etc. that join TTA with a demonstrative interest in promoting the cause of TTA, having material interest in the activities of TTA. Ordinary member shall be further classified into two sub-categories: full members and associate members. Full members shall be those members that directly participate in developing standards as well as studies and research related thereto. Associate members shall be those members that join TTA for the primary purpose of obtaining developed standards as well as the results of studies and research.
- ③ Special members shall be further classified into two sub-categories: entity (or group) members and individuals. Entity (or group) members shall be academic circles, industry and technology associations and consortia, related agencies etc. that TTA recognizes as necessary partners to cooperate with. Individual members shall be those persons, who have sufficient knowledge and experience in the field of information and telecommunications, that TTA recognizes as members to contribute to the achievement of the purpose.

Article 3 (Admission to Membership)

- ① TTA shall promote membership in TTA by advertising, once every year regularly, in a daily newspaper published in the City of Seoul.

- ② Any individual or entity that intends to join TTA shall submit an application for membership according to Form No. 1 attached as Attachment 1 to TTA. However, this shall not apply to special memberships.

Article 4 (Annual Dues)

- ① Each member of TTA is obligated to pay annual dues for membership according to the unit class of annual dues applicable to its membership category, or higher than that class, as stipulated in “The schedule of Unit Class of Annual Dues by Membership Category” which is shown in Table No. 1 attached as Attachment 3. However, the unit class of annual dues for a member, who is an elected officer of TTA, shall be determined by the Board of Directors, taking into account the unit class and amount paid in the previous year. (Amended as of Oct. 21, 1997)
- ② Instead of paying into annual dues for memberships as prescribed in the preceding Paragraph, a member may donate a sum of money to TTA. In such case, the returns on that money at a normal public interest rate must exceed the annual dues that the member has to pay.
- ③ The returns on the money donated by a member as prescribed in the preceding Paragraph may be continually carried forward to succeeding business years. However, when the returns on the money donated fall short of the annual dues for any particular year, the balance must be paid to TTA by the member concerned.
- ④ Annual dues for membership shall, in principle, be paid during the first quarter of each year. However, a member that joins TTA on or after July 1 shall pay one half of its annual dues for that year.(Amended as of Oct. 21, 1997)
- ⑤ During the period specified in Paragraph 4 above, the membership of a member that paid its annual dues for the previous year shall be deemed valid. If, however, any payment of annual dues is not made within that period, the Secretary-General shall cause a written notice to be sent to the member whose payment is delinquent. If the member fails to make payment within thirty (30) days after such notice, the Secretary-General shall cause the voting rights of that member, as provided for in Article 7, to be suspended. (Amended as of Oct. 21, 1997)
- ⑥ Special members as provided for in Article 2 Paragraph 3 , and an entity or organization that was exempted from the payment of annual dues by the Board of Directors shall have no obligation to pay annual dues to TTA.
- ⑦ Each year, the Secretary-General shall issue a certificate of membership in TTA, according to Form No.2 attached as Attachment 2, to each member that has completed the payment of its annual dues. (Amended as of Oct. 21, 1997)

Article 5 (Membership Obligations)

A member of TTA shall have the following obligations:

1. To observe and comply with the Articles of Association and rules and bylaws of TTA;
2. To observe and comply with the decisions and resolutions of the Board of Directors;
3. To make payment of annual dues for membership
4. To observe and comply with and disseminate the decisions and resolutions of the Technical Assembly for Information and Telecommunications Standards (hereinafter referred to as “the Technical Assembly”)
5. To participate, positively and actively, in the activities of TTA

Article 6 (Membership Rights)

The scope of activities in which members are entitled to participate as well as the rights of members are as set forth in Table No. 2 attached as attachment 4.

Article 7 (Voting Right)

- ① Each member of TTA shall have a right to vote upon important matters such as development, revision and abolition of standards. An associate member, however, shall have no right to vote. (Amended as of Oct. 21, 1997)
- ② When voting upon decisions or resolutions of the Technical Assembly, the number of votes of a full member shall be equal to the number of units of annual dues the member has already paid to TTA, while a special member shall have only one (1) vote. However, no one member shall have one third or more of the total votes. (Amended as of Oct. 21, 1997 and as of July 28, 1998)
- ③ The voting right and the number of votes as prescribed in Paragraph 2 above shall apply only to the decisions and resolutions of the Technical Assembly.
- ④ Matters regarding voting right not provided for in these rules shall be determined, as appropriate, by the Technical Assembly.

Article 8 (Withdrawal and Expulsion from Membership)

- ① Any member that intends to withdraw from membership or leave TTA shall give a written notice to that effect to TTA.
- ② Any member that falls under any one of the following Sub-paragraphs shall, by a resolution of the Board of Directors, be subject to expulsion from membership in TTA:
 1. When the member has defamed or injured the reputation of TTA;
 2. When the member has violated any of the obligations or duties as a member;
 3. When the member, who is a juridical person, has been dissolved;
 4. When the Board of Directors deems it necessary to expel the member for other reasons.

- ③ When a member is in default of payment of its annual dues for more than six (6) months, its membership shall be suspended. (Amended as of Oct. 21, 1997)
- ④ When a member withdraws or is expelled from membership, the balance of the annual dues already paid to TTA, for the remaining months of the year, shall be refunded upon request by the member. With this, the rights and privileges of the member shall lapse.

Article 9 (Delegation to the Secretary-General)

Matters for the implementation of these rules not provided for herein shall be separately prescribed by the Secretary-General.

1. Unit Class of Annual Dues for Full Membership:

Note:

1. The gross sales of members that are telecommunications service operator and equipment manufacturers shall be the gross sales in information and telecommunications section for the previous year.
2. The unit sales of R&D institutes or organizations that have revenue from sales shall be fixed on the basis of their total budgets for the current year.
3. The unit class of new companies without revenue from normal sales shall be fixed on the basis of their capital as follows;
 - (1) Unit class 4 for companies capitalized at 500 billion KRW or more;
 - (2) Unit class 5 for companies capitalized at 100 billion KRW or more;
 - (3) Unit class 6 for companies capitalized at 10 billion KRW or more;
 - (4) Unit class 7 for companies capitalized at less than 10 billion.

2. Unit Class of Annual Dues for Associate Members shall be 1/2 of 1 Unit.
